How Can I Participate?

Dance Performance Teams (DPT) will be formed by sign-ups rather than auditions for students from Combo A + B. Students in Levels 1 - 6, who were in attendance for summer classes, are eligible to audition for Dance Performance Teams.

What Do DPT Do?

Our Dance Performance Teams work together to create routines designed specifically to entertain the community. These routines are usually holiday oriented and may be in Ballet, Tap, Musical Theater or Jazz - choreographer's choice.

Are There Separate Classes?

DPT members do meet separately from their own core technique classes. In this way, students can focus on the creativity and performance aspects of each piece. Each DPT will meet weekly for a period of 6-8 weeks to complete each routine. Please check the fall schedule for dates and times.

Is There a Separate Tuition Fee?

There is a \$50.00 choreography fee (from each student) for each routine created. There are no additional class fees.

Is There a Costume Charge?

We try our best to keep costuming to a minimum. Many times we can utilize studio accessories. Parents may be asked to purchase holiday colored leotard or shirts, depending on the theme of each routine. Occasionally we can use costumes from previous recitals.

Where Do DPT Perform?

Historically, our dancers along with our vocal department, will perform for area nursing homes, the local mall, local celebrations and other venues. We are available to perform when requested. We try to book 4-6 holiday shows during each season.

What Are the Benefits of Being a DPT Dancer?

The benefits are many:

- Students enjoy more class time, therefore there is more training
- This is a short commitment— only 6-8 weeks
- DPT builds camaraderie among dancers
- Gives the students the opportunity to entertain and bring joy to others
- Trains the dancers to learn quicker
